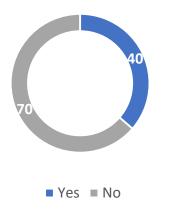

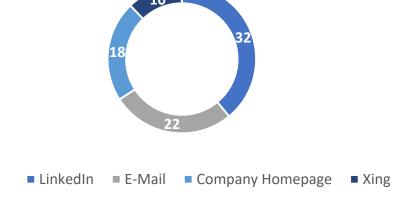
Do you apply videos?

Which channels do you use for video messaging?

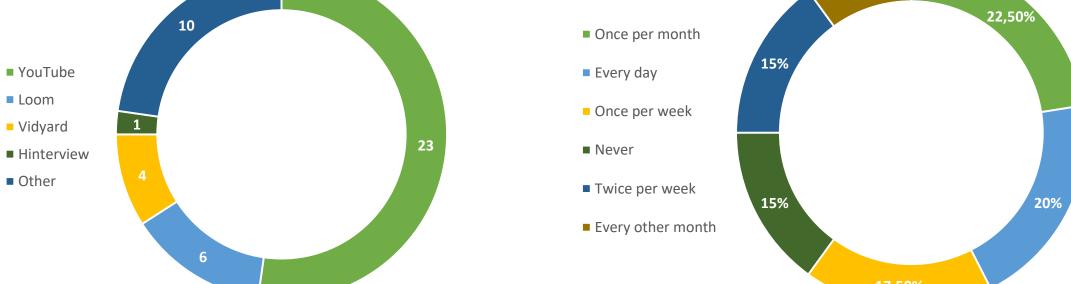

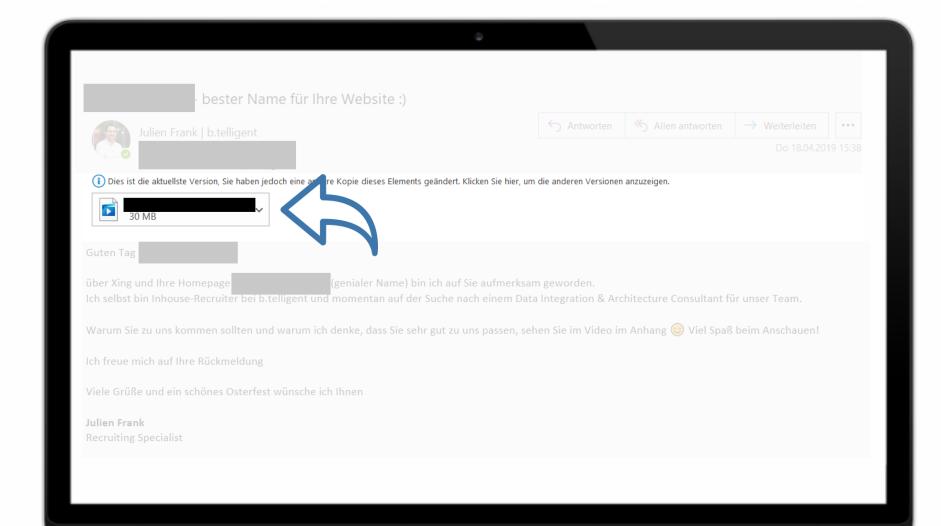

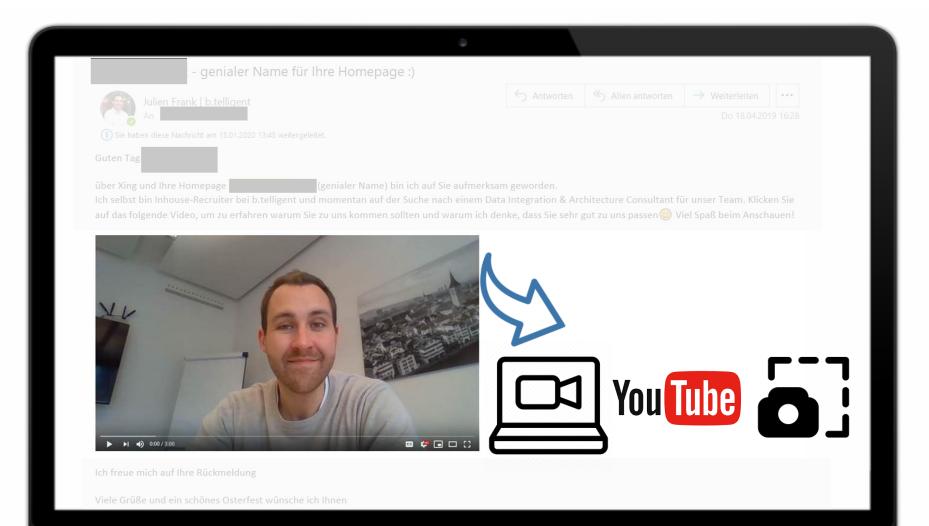

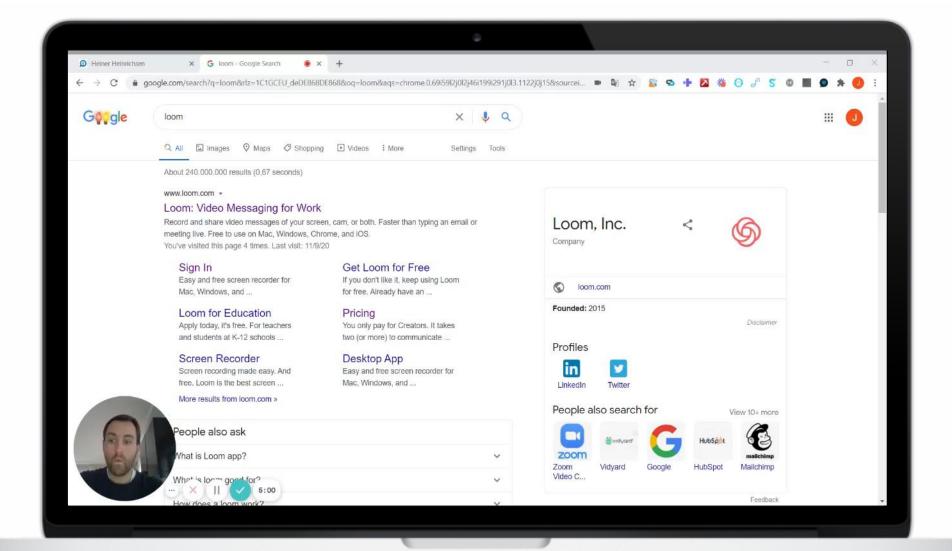

Pros & Cons



- One of the most personal outreach methods
- In comparison to other recruiters, you definitely stick out
- High level of appreciation: You put extra efforts and time into your messages
- Candidates receive deeper insights into a company's culture and its employees
- More variety in your daily sourcing game
- You receive an external perspective



- It can be more time-consuming
- Making a good video doesn't automatically mean that it gets seen by candidates
- Sending links could be classified as spam
- You cannot watch videos in every location
- Depending on your target group videos might be perceived as strange

- No authenticity
- Inconsistency
- Resting on your laurels
- Bad quality





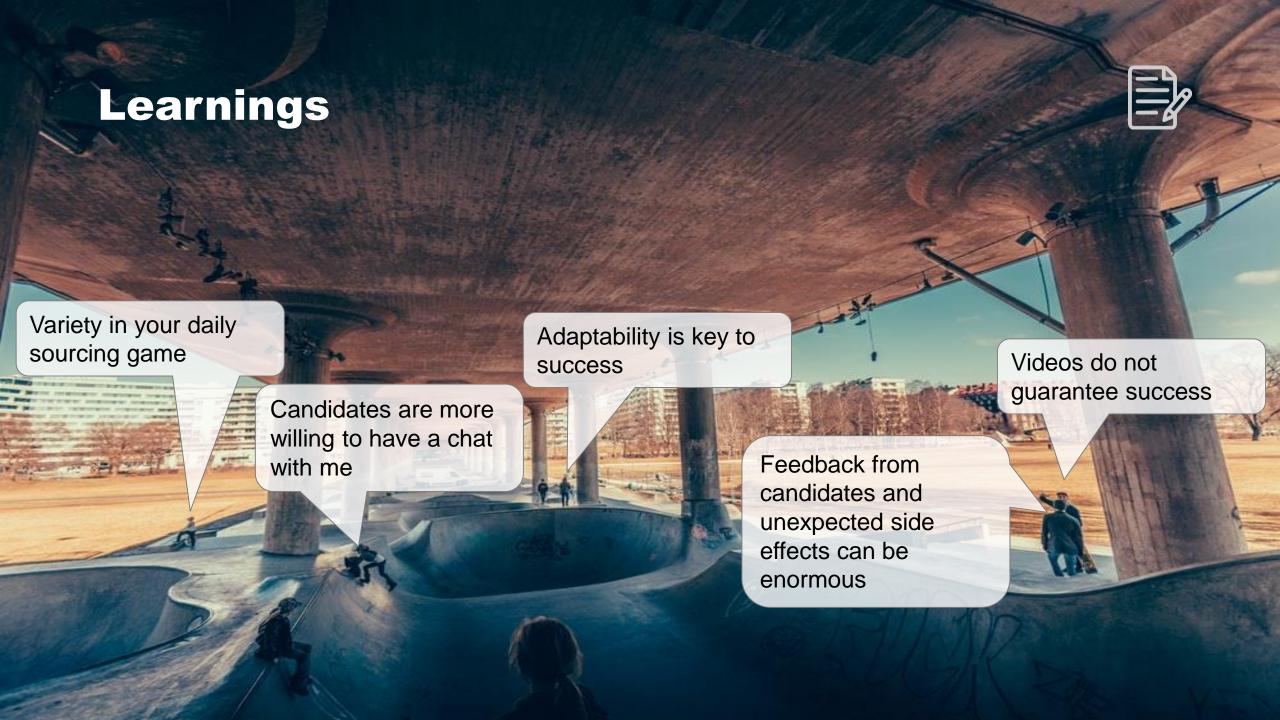
Pros & Cons



- You are able to reach several people at once and thereby save time
- Even though you're "mass-mailing" people, you can still be personal
- Candidates receive deeper insights into a company's culture and its employees



- Setting up a campaign with One2Lead or Lemlist can be time-consuming
- The written message should not be neglected
- Deliverability could be a problem
